Keith Clarke CBE to give the eighth Happold Medal Lecture

Keith Clarke CBE, former chairman of the Construction Industry Council (2008-2010), will give this year's lecture and become the eighth recipient of the prestigious Happold Medal Award, which is awarded jointly by the Construction Industry Council and the Happold Trust.

Established in 1998, the Happold Medal Lecture is held in memory of the CIC's first chairman, Professor Sir Edmund (Ted) Happold, the founding senior partner of Buro Happold.

Keith Clarke will receive the Happold Medal after delivering a lecture entitled, 'Who holds the pencil?', which will focus on sustainable developments. The lecture will take place on Wednesday, November 14th, 6pm-9pm, at The Institution of Structural Engineers, 11 Upper Belgrave Street, London SW1X 8BH.
